This prevents energy losses and saves heating costs.

When buying carpets, seals such as GuT (Association of Environmentally Friendly Carpets) help you identify good quality and avoid harmful substances. However, to ensure an odorless and healthy home, it's just as important to know what's underneath the carpet. For this reason, make sure to always use solvent-free dispersion adhesives for fixing the carpet.
